Aga Khan Foundation Canada requires that donors wanting this information request it through emails to info@akfc.ca

Additional context:

- The Donor Bill of Rights of 1993 Article 3 states that all donors have the right to receive the most recent financial statements.
- The Charities Directorate states that it is best practice for charities to post financial statements on their websites.
- 92% of Canadian Major charities, like the Aga Khan Foundation Canada, post their audited financial statements for multiple years on their websites.
